Each school should hold a minimum of 2 Asthma Emergency Kits. One to be kept at the school and one available to be taken off site, for sporting activities, camps and excursions.

Each kit should contain-

- Reliever Medication (check expiry dates)
- Spacer
- Emergency Kit card
- 70% alcohol swabs (for cleaning)
